#### SEARLES EIGHT YEAR PRESERVATION PROGRAM

During the Township Committee meeting, it was agreed to keep any MUA responses on Searles Preservation Program brief and factual. It was agreed that the MUA needs to have this site available until it is determined that the well site is not required.

### SMITH WELL

There is a period of 45 days to file an appeal on the Judge's decision regarding the condemnation. Next steps are as follows:

- J. Gregory to send letter to Ag Board with the MUA support of the finalization of the Smith farm preservation
- J. Gregory to send a letter requesting reinstatement of the existing well permits.
- MUA to request estimate to obtain DEP approval and submission for Scheffler and Smith wells.
- Need to resolve property crossing issues to access easement as well as pump house.
- J. Gregory to determine if Stothoff contract is viable or if it will need to be re-bid.
