EMPLOYEE ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT

The research that M. Pucilowski did, with regard to pay for recuperation time as well as overtime for time worked, was discussed. It was agreed to use the Township DPW contract as a template for the WTMUA contract including paying overtime for any time over 40 hours inclusive of paid time off.

M. Pucilowski has some concerns of about the rotating shifts. Those concerns are related to the small staff and the ability of the staff to be knowledgeable about the entire system to ensure experienced coverage at all times. A review of what needs to be done on the weekends will be reviewed to see if there can be a reduction of hours for weekend duties. Additionally there needs to be some cross training.

It was agreed to do a sewer tour for the Commissioners in five weeks when B. Carpenter is on weekend duty.

The uniform program is still being explored. Additional vendors are scheduled to provide quotes.
